

Elena Cervantes Fine Arts Scholarship, Application 2025.

Scholarship Description:

The Edmonds SnoKing Branch of the American Association of University Women (<u>aauw.org</u>) is accepting applications for one \$2,000 Fine Arts scholarship to be awarded to a student identifying as female and graduating in 2025 from a high school in Edmonds, Everett, or Marysville School Districts.

Eligible applicants are those who intend to enter a Fine Arts-focused program at an institution of higher learning in the following academic year.

Fine Arts Eligibility Requirements: For our AAUW Fine Arts Scholarship, Fine Arts are defined as the study and creation of visual/tangible works of art, including but not limited to painting, drawing, sculpture, ceramics, photography, etc.

All art pieces must be original in fabrication and concept. two-dimensional and/or three-dimensional work may be submitted. Digital portfolio must be submitted via PDF.

Portfolio should include five to ten examples of your *strongest* completed work along with descriptions. Descriptions must include the medium and technique utilized, along with a short narrative of the work and what messaging you intend to convey to the viewer.

Awards will be determined on a competitive basis and require the submission of all components, an art portfolio, letter of recommendation and the completion of the personal essay. Additionally, applicants must submit a copy of their most recent transcript to be deemed eligible.

Scholarship recipients will be required to attend a Scholarship Awards Ceremony on June 7, 2025 at Edmonds College, Woodway Hall from 10am-12pm.
